r Aishatu Yusha'u Armiya'u was appointed on the 2nd of August 2022 as the fifth and first female Medical Director of Federal Neuro-Psychiatric Hospital Kaduna.

Her well-deserved appointment comes at the time when the Hospital needs a Dedicated, Trustworthy, Prudent, and Transparent Leader.

On assumption of duty on the 22nd of August 2022, Dr. Aishatu Yusha'u Armiya'u immediately set out to transform the Hospital into a center of excellence and a psychiatric institution of global standard both functionally and infrastructurally.

Within her first year of milestone, Dr. Aishatu Yusha'u Armiya'u epitomizes leadership, capacity, focus, passion, resilience, hard work, commitment, high taste, class, sacrifice, service, selflessness, accountability, effectiveness, efficiency and dedication to duty. Global in her orientation, but local in her approach.

Dr. Aishatu Yusha'u Armiya'u possesses a strong goal-oriented mentality and the ability to motivate her team to pursue mutual objectives. She is soft on people, but harsh on standard. Within a month in office, she was able to design a clear mission, vision and core values for the Hospital.

Using effective strategies, she successfully created a team-oriented work environment and a clear operating metrics.

An Associate professor of Forensic Psychiatry and one of the most celebrated academicians in Nigeria with over one hundred publications to her credit in local and international journals,

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Dr. Aishatu Yusha'u Armiya'u has shown her willingness to deploy all her expertise and passion for mental health to reposition neuropsychiatric services in Nigeria and indeed Africa to meet a global standard.

Dr. Aishatu Yusha'u Armiya'u was preceded by the late Dr. Yusuf Abdulkareem Jika a Professor of Psychiatry from 2018 to 2021, Dr. Taiwo Lateef Sheikh also a Professor of Psychiatry from 2010 to 2018, Dr. G.T. Suleiman from 2001 to 2009 and late Dr. Muhammed Habib Ahmed a Professor of Psychiatry from 1996 to 2001.



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Historical Background

HISTORICAL BACKGROUND

Federal Neuro-psychiatric Hospital is a tertiary Health Institution established in 1996 located in Kaduna, North West Nigeria. The institution is well positioned to meet the Mental Health needs of all Nigerians particularly individuals from states such as Kaduna, Kano, Jigawa, Katsina, Gombe, Bauchi, Plateau, Niger, FCT and Zamfara.

The Institution renders its services to the general public within the Hospital premises and in rural communities through community Psychiatry Programme.

The Institution has the following mandates:

1. Treatment and management of mentally challenged individuals.

2.Training of Resident Doctors and Nurses in Psychiatric Medicine and Post basic Psychiatric Nursing, respectively.

3.Research in Mental Health and related fields.

Federal Neuro-psychiatric Hospital has the following facilities designed to meet the needs of mentally challenged individuals:

1. Male Ward (80 patients' capacity).

2.Female Ward (46 patients' capacity).

3.Child and Adolescent Ward (30 patients capacity).

4. Emergency Ward (20 patients' capacity).

5. The General Out-patients Department (GOPD) which serves hundreds of patients daily.

6. Drugs Addiction Therapy and Rehabilitation Ward (DATAR) (60 patients capacity)

7. NHIA clinic and Electroencephalography (EEG).
8. Well-equipped Laboratory and Bio molecular Laboratory services.
9. Amenity Psychiatric services.

10. Dialysis Services

11. Pharmaceutical services.

On assumption of duty, Dr. Aishatu Yusha'u Armiya'u deployed her natural tendencies for an organized, clean and scenic environment to design a clear and concise direction for the institution going forward. The new Medical Director paid visits to all the units in the Hospital, interacted with all staff, noted and documented all their concerns in details and made observations on how to enhance productivity of each unit. During her visits to the various units, the Medical Director promised to address all genuine concerns raised, as well as take the necessary steps that will be required for each unit to perform optimally.

Within her first year in office, Dr. Aishatu Yusha'u Armiya'u has been able to address over 90% of the issues raised by the various units in addition to the new innovations introduced and implemented in all the units, in line with the vision and mission of the institution.

Some of those notable milestones are as follows:

A. She accomplished a comprehensive structural Organogram which provide a clear direction and purpose going forward.

B. Establishment of Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) for all the units, departments and directorates for the purpose of instilling professional discipline among staff of the institution; the first of its kind in the Hospital.

C. First institution in Nigeria to implement the modern Performance Management System (PMS) in line with guidelines from the office of the Head of Civil Service of the Federation.

D. Constitution of a Progress and Strategic Report Committee to work with each unit within the Hospital to ensure a SMART design and implementation of institutional goals to optimized quality service delivery. **E.** Inauguration of a planning unit with a planning team to work closely with Hospital Management in implementing institutional goals

F. Issuance of a clear schedule of duty to all staff of the Hospital in a bid to promote efficiency and effectiveness.

G. Organization of pending promotion exercise; conducted and concluded.

H. Securing of the much-needed cash backing from the office of Director General Budget Office. This allowed the pending employment exercise to be carried out successfully.

I. Regularization of all necessary documentation to enable all the staff who transferred their services to the Hospital receive their salaries.

J. Prompt settlement of staff outstanding salaries from the months before her arrival.

K. Employment of staff to strengthen service delivery. This includes eighty (80) staff on permanent and pensionable basis of which

a. Fifty eight (58) are senior staff and

b. Twenty two (22) are junior staff.

c.Over thirty (30) staff were equally employed on locum appointment.

L. Proactively took necessary steps to resolve the persistent security challenges within the Hospital. New security contractor was engaged, the office of the Hospital security supervisor was created and improved remuneration and condition of service for the security personnel was ensured.

M. Provision of uniforms and improved working conditions for compound cleaners.

N. Discouragement of the culture of 'I-owe you' provision from the cash and revenue office in order to instill discipline and accountability.

O. Ensuring of 100% implementation and payment of all 2022 Capital budgets.

QUALITY SERVICE DELIVERY

Within her first year, Dr. Aishatu Yusha'u Armiya'u demonstrated her capacity for innovations and proper utilization of scarce resources to greatly improve service delivery within the hospital as follows:

a. Waiting time at the Emergency unit of the Hospital is reduced by 75%. This is made possible by provision of essential services previously not available at the emergency unit. The Emergency unit of the Hospital is now equipped with additional consulting rooms, Pharmacy unit, Laboratory service unit, cashier, social welfare services and additional beds for emergency patient admission. The Medical Director is equally credited with the creation of a patient's Restraining team that is adequately equipped with working tools and professional training. This innovation represent first of its kind in all health institutions in the country.

b. The general out-patient's department (GOPD) of the Hospital has been decongested. This was done through clear assignment of patients visiting days and time which allows Doctors adequate time to properly interact with patients and clients in a work-friendly environment.

c. Under the leadership of Dr. Aishatu Yusha'u Armiya'u, Federal Neuro-psychiatric Hospital Kaduna now offers Dialysis services with Psychotherapy for both Non aseptic and Aseptic cases. These services represent the first of its kind nationwide. The additional Psychotherapy has greatly addressed the usual psychological trauma being experience by patients receiving dialysis.

d. The institution now offers modern sophisticated X-Ray and ultrasound services as part of expansion in service delivery within the Hospital.

e. As part of her innovations, Dr. Aishatu Yusha'u Armiya'u created a toxicology ward, an idea that was previously nonexistence. The toxicology ward allows the separation of Psychiatric patients diagnosed with various forms of Psychiatric conditions from those with substance use disorder. This permits the design of a clear plan for the management and rehabilitation of people with substance use disorder.

f. Under the leadership of Dr. Aishatu Yusha'u Armiya'u, drug information and Pharmacovigilance units have been created in the Pharmacy department. These units are responsible for the provision of drugs related information and creating awareness on the presence of dangerous and substandard Pharmaceutical to both the staff and patients within the institution.

g. The Pharmacy department has been provided a functional and equipped compounding unit which is responsible for the production of all the relevant consumables needed in the Hospital. The MD within her first year in office ensured that all consumables needed in the Hospital are produced by the Pharmacy department.

h. Federal Neuropsychiatric Hospital Kaduna now has a well-equipped and functional bimolecular laboratory for handling highly infectious Biological samples and biomedical research.

I. The institution now has a functional website and renders professional front-desk services which are created to inform and educate the general public, both at home and abroad on the activities and services being rendered by the institution.

j. Federal Neuropsychiatric Hospital Kaduna now renders a comprehensive NHIA services which covers an extensive area of Medical Practice with full accreditation.

k. In order to minimize patient's waiting time and to achieve accelerated service delivery, additional cashier and payment points have been created. These services include the provision of Point of sale (POS) for ease of financial transactions between the Hospital and clients.

I. The Hospital now operates incinerator services for effective disposal of medical waste. m. The institution under the leadership of Dr. Aishatu Yusha'u Armiya'u has signed a build-operate-and transfer (BOT) agreement with a private investor for the provision of canteen and related services to the staff of the Hospital.

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FACILITY AND RESOURCE CONTROL MANAGEMENT

Despite working with scarce resources in her first year in change, Dr. Aishatu Yusha'u Armiya'u demonstrated excellent resource management, prudency, accountability, sense of personal sacrifices and proper allocation of resources. The institution under the leadership of Dr. Aishatu Yusha'u Armiya'u is now equipped with the following facilities:

a. Electronic Health Medical Record System; this positioned the institution among the best in the country in automated service delivery, accelerated service delivery and accountability.



b. Solar Energy; the Hospital now has alternative power supply to guarantee uninterrupted service delivery.



c. Under the leadership of Dr. Aishatu Yusha'u Armiya'u, three generators (2 units of 50kva and 1 unit of 150kva) have been installed at the Emergency unit, the medical laboratory and the Covid 19 intervention project site to sustain uninterrupted power supply to the Dialysis section, X-Ray and USS center, the bimolecular laboratory, and the Amenity ward all in the complex.

d. New vehicles have been purchased for Community Psychiatric Outreach and utility purposes with vehicles service bay and maintenance area being constructed.



e. New EEG machine has been installed.



f. Installation and commissioning of eleven thousand (11,000) liters diesel tank/reservoir for the institution.



g. For the first time in the history of the Hospital mosquito nets have been installed on all the windows of the wards in the institution.

I. Newly constructed Isolation Centre has been converted into Amenity ward in the newly constructed Covid-19 intervention complex named after her immediate predecessor Late Prof. Abdulkareem Yusuf Jika.

Dr. Aishatu Yusha'u Armiya'u within her first year as the Medical Director initiated some notable infrastructural development projects in the institution. These projects include the following:

a. Construction of Hospital gate and renovation of perimeter fence.

b. Re-Asphalting of 2.5 kilometer access road and car packs within the Hospital.

c. Construction of geriatric ward.





Under the leadership of Dr. Aishatu Yusha'u Armiya'u the department has the c. Under the stewardship of Dr. Aishatu Yusha'u Armiya'u, the School of Post basic Psychiatric Nursing has been issued full accreditation by the Nursing and Midwifery Council of Nigeria. This allows the school to review the number of students to be admitted to fifty (50) students from previous maximum of thirty (30) students.

d. The School of Post Basic Psychiatric Nursing (SPBPN) has commenced Computer Base Test (CBT).

e. Ten (10) Medical laboratory Scientist have been trained on the operations of bimolecular laboratory.

f. Four (4) Nurses are undergoing training at the School of Post Basic Psychiatric Nursing.

g. Six (6) Nurses have been given approval to attend various degree programs.

h. Nineteen (19) other staff from Account and Finance, Audit unit, Administration, Procurement, Dialysis unit, Laboratory, Maintenance, Health Information unit and attendants have equally been given approval to obtain various training certificates.


SAVE THE TREES


